Most School Spirit

Presented to a male and female

Who have exhibited support for and dedication to the school, faculty, and fellow students.

Our Most Versatile Award

Presented to a male and female

Who are capable of doing many things. They have the ability to turn easily from one subject, activity, or task to another.

The Most Talented Award

Presented to a male and female

Who have superior natural endowment or ability in areas such as art, athletic ability, or music.

Most Intellectual Awards

Presented to both a male and a female.

Factors used to determine this award are:

Grade Point Average

ACT Scores

Other academic considerations. Example: Classroom Performance

Service Award

Presented to an outstanding senior who has:

Given outstanding service to the school, faculty, and fellow students.

Works outside the realm of the classroom to assist others.

L. O. Atkins

The L.O. Atkins Award is presented to an outstanding student in the senior class who exhibits scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and service to the school.

E. T. Hawkins

The E. T. Hawkins Award is presented to an outstanding student in the senior class who exhibits scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and service to the school.

The Balfour Award

Presented to a graduating senior who has displayed exceptional scholarship, citizenship, and leadership.

The Hall of Fame Awards

Based on a student's:

**GPA – Only students with a 90 or above average as of
December of the prior semester are considered.**

Participation in extracurricular activities

The process for selection occurs as listed below:

Hall of Fame:

-Each teacher has one ballot but votes for 8 people
