RE: 2014 Accountability Results: School Differentiated Accountability Designations

During the 2011-2012 school year, Mississippi sought and received waivers from certain No Child Left Behind (NCLB) requirements through the ESEA Flexibility Request. The purpose of this letter is to describe the educational opportunities made possible by Mississippi's Flexibility Request and to help you understand what the Request will mean for you and your child.

Your child's school, Forest High School, has been identified as a Focus School. Forest High School's 4-Year Graduation Rate was 61.7%. The goal was 71%. Forest High School did, however, meet the goal [AMO] in Reading/Language Arts & Math. The school has conducted a comprehensive needs assessment and will implement the following interventions:

- Develop a Leadership Team that will meet regularly to analyze school performance data and classroom observation data to make decisions about school improvement and professional development needs
- Develop Instructional Teams that will meet for blocks of time to develop and refine units of instruction and review student learning data.

The school will also develop and implement an action plan that addresses areas of deficiency. Through improvement objectives and a system of continuous monitoring, the school will evaluate the action plan throughout the year. A community council will be established and will actively participate in action plan implementation.
